In some parts of Cameroon, genital mutilation is a traditional practice that is still very common.

There are women whose profession is to incise or mutilate the genitals of girls and women. They do this with the aid of instruments that are very crude and unhygienic. These women are not medically trained and they do not always pay attention to basic hygiene. Unfortunately, the effects of genital mutilation last for life. Some girls bleed a lot and others suffer serious difficulties during childbirth.

The aim of genital mutilation is to stop promiscuity in girls. Genital mutilation removes the specific part of the woman's body that gives enjoyment during sexual intercourse. It is felt that this part of a woman's body leads girls to become promiscuous.

However, in recent years genital mutilation has been identified as a specific case of violence against women and girls. I think you will agree that this is true. Girls and women do not request genital mutilation but they have it imposed on them. The procedure is cruel, unnecessary and usually irreversible. Girls cannot return to their natural state later in life if they so desire.

I think those involved in genital mutilation should find other ways of earning a living. They can work on farms for instance, instead of violating the human rights of women and girls.
