Or they can record their disapproval by voting in someone to replace them. Elected officials are accountable to the people who vote them into office.

Reporter : But what if the person you support does not win an election?

Official: Not everyone can win an election. If a person wins , it is the will of the majority of the people. Good leaders accept defeat in democratic elections. Think of how Abdoulaye Wade conceded defeat to Macky Sall in Senegal; Nicolas Sarkozy defeat to Francois Hollande in France. these men are shining examples of the upside of democracy.
