#### Two stadia excluded

The African Football Confederation has just decided to exclude two stadia that hosted the last edition of the Africa Cup of Nation (AFCON) from the list of approved stadia for the qualifiers for the next edition of the competition. Indeed, the governing body of African football did not validate the Ahmadou Ahidjo and Olembé stadia. The two football fields did not meet the requirement standards to host international football encounters. Unlike the Ahmadou Ahidjo and Olembé stadia, the reunification and Japoma stadia in Douala, and Roumde Adjia in Garoua met the African Football Confederation standards. The football governing body thus approved the three stadia to host the fifth day of qualifiers for the 2023 AFCON edition to be hosted by Ivory coast.
