Carefully read the following passage and answer the questions that follows.

The Influence of television

Television is the most influential form of media. The average American watches TV more than four hours a day. Preschoolers spend more time watching TV than doing anything else except sleeping. Research shows that children six months to six years old spend on an average two hours a day watching TV, using a computer or playing a video game. That is three times as long as they spend reading or being read to. By the time the children are sixteen they will have spent more time watching TV than going to school. As a result, children are exposed to about 20.000 advertisements a year. By the time the child graduates from high school, he will have witnessed 13.000 violent deaths on TV. The radio is hardly being listened to these days.

Television influences both children's social and antisocial behaviors, as well as their attitudes about race and gender. As children grow and develop they take in information and acquire knowledge at a rapid pace. Young children will imitate and repeat behaviors that they see on TV. According to the National Institute of Mental Health, there is a consensus developing amongst members of the research community that violence on TV does lead to aggressive behavior by children and teenagers who watch violent and aggressive programs.

Television also discourages face to face interaction amongst children and families. Besides, stories and night story times are now things of the past. The children look up to the television for their moral lesson than to their parents. For that reason, parents have been called archaic, old school and not flowing with the modern ways of doing things. Is modern technology actually the best ? Though television provides some good role models for children, television programs now model an undesirable behavior such as drug and alcohol use or unhealthy relationship. Sitting passively in front of the TV also leads to weight gain, increasing the chances of diabetes in children and heart disease in adults. Children are also known to wear glasses at a very tender age due to long exposure to the TV screen. In spite of this argument in favor of television being a bad influence, TV is an inexpensive way to get information. It is the most popular way nowadays to get informed.
