- Secondly, type out the receiver's address in the recipient box for example your receiver's address can be aye_ enyegue23@gmail.com. Next, use "Cc" (Carbon Copy) or "Bcc" (blind carbon copy) to include other receivers.
- After this is done, write a subject for your email. A subject is a brief indication of what the email is all about.
- Then write the body of your email: the part in which you write out the letter or communicate information. You may want to include any necessary attachments: elements other than the text such as images or documents.
- Finally, send your email by pressing the button that reads "send". After sending your email, you can navigate to your inbox to check for replies.
