Text:

1 Nowadays, the number of people infected with Sexually transmitted Diseases (STDs) is increasing dangerously. The most popular are herpes, gonorrhoea, syphilis and chancroids. But the most dreadful is AIDS (Acquired Immunodeficiency syndrome), causing the death of more than forty-two million people all over the world. They are infected with HIV (Human Immunodeficiency Virus), the virus that causes AIDS. People, especially young boys and girls, catch STDS through sexual intercourse. But they can also catch them by other means such as syringe and sharpen tools exchange, for example the process of drug ta king. People who suffer from AIDS become thinner and thinner, they cough and spit blood waiting for death to carry them away.

2 The best way to stop the STDs is to observe abstinence, faithfulness to one's sexual partner and the use of condom for protection. People should also avoid used syringe and razor blades.

3 Not everybody who gets the virus will immediately become ill. They may remain perfectly healthy for a long time but they can still pass the virus on to others. These people are "carriers" of the virus.

4 Health education is very important. We must know how to protect ourselves against AIDS and how to avoid spreading it to others. Everybody in the community should be educated, not just adults. Remember, anyone can catch AIDS.
